Subject: Extension of the timeline for filing the questionnaire responses by the interested parties pertaining to the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of “Certain Antioxidants” originating in or exported from China PR, Korea RP and Singapore – reg.

1. The Authority has initiated the subject investigation vide Initiation Notification No. 6/33/2026-DGTR, dated 24.06.2026.
2. As per the Notice dated 14.08.2026, regarding the scope of the PUC/PCN methodology and the submission of questionnaire responses, all interested parties i.e., producers/ exporters/ importers/ users, etc. were required to submit their respective questionnaire responses by 29.08.2026.
3. In response to requests from certain interested parties seeking an extension of the time-limit to file questionnaire responses, the requests have been duly considered, and it has been decided to extend the timeline from 29.08.2026 to 07.09.2026.
4. Since the trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted to file the questionnaire responses in the captioned subject matter.
