Subject: Extension of the timeline for filing the questionnaire responses by the interested parties pertaining to the anti-dumping investigation concerning imports of "Thermal Paper or Thermal Sensitive Paper" originating in or exported from USA, China PR and the Republic of Korea – reg.

1. The Authority has initiated the subject investigation vide Initiation Notification No. F. No. 06/25/2026-DGTR, dated 24.06.2026.
2. As per the Notice dated 21.08.2026, regarding the scope of the PUC/PCN methodology and the submission of questionnaire responses, all interested parties i.e., producers/exporters/importers/users, etc. were required to submit their respective questionnaire responses by 04.09.2026.
3. In response to requests from certain interested parties seeking an extension of the time-limit to file questionnaire responses, the requests have been duly considered, and it has been decided to extend the timeline from 04.09.2026 to 11.09.2026.
4. Since the trade remedial investigations are time-bound in nature, no further extension of time will be granted to file the questionnaire responses in the captioned subject matter.
